Alberta Bowl Pre Game Protocol

- Please do not arrive earlier than one (1) hour and 10 minutes prior to kick-off
- If you are the first game to play, your warm-ups are 45 minutes prior to game time
- If you have a game preceding, you must wait until the conclusion of the Awards Ceremony for the prior game before to taking the field for warm-up
- The clock will be set to run 0:00; five minutes prior to the scheduled kick-off of your game
- With 10 minutes left on the clock prior to your game, please return to your locker room
- At 0:00 you will be expected to have your team lined up in numerical order in the walkway by your change room leading onto the field
- Visiting team will be announced first as they enter the field. Northwest entrance to the field from the change rooms
- Home team will be announced second as they enter the field. Southwest entrance to the field from the change rooms
- Both teams will line up on their respective 45-yard line. DO NOT GO TO YOUR BENCH

3 Minutes before game time - Referees will be introduced

2 minutes before game time - Captains will be called to center field for the coin toss

1 minutes before game time - Playing of the National Anthem



What to do when an injury occurs	 When coming in contact with the injured student/athlete, take control and assess the situation. Exercise universal precautions related to blood and body fluids. Do NOT move the injured person. Send someone to get the onsite First Aid help. They will take charge. Assess the injury-evaluate the severity of the injury and decide if further assistance is required. If an ambulance is not needed, decide what action is to be taken to remove the injured party for the playing surface. If an ambulance is required-request that another person calls 911. Have them report back to you with an estimated time of arrival and send them to the entrance to wait. Observe the injured party carefully for any changes in condition When the ambulance arrives, describe the incident and what has been done An adult should be designated to accompany the injured party to the hospital. Contact the parent/guardian of the injured athlete/student 		
Fire Alarm & Evacuation Procedures	All fire alarms are to be treated as emergencies. As soon as the fire alarm sounds, a complete evacuation of the facility will commence. All guests at Hansen Lincoln Field will leave in an orderly fashion to the closest emergency exit. When it can be determined that the facility is safe to be re-entered, the City of Grande Prairie staff will make an announcement to the group.		

USER GROUP & SPECTATOR RULES

To ensure you have a safe and positive experience at the Facility, your adherence to these rules is required. Any person who violates any of these rules may be ticketed and/or required to leave.

SPECTATOR & USER CONDUCT:	 Spectators must be seated, except prior to the start of the event, during intermissions, and after the conclusion of the event. Crowding on the stairs or landings is prohibited. Spectators must remain outside the fenced area of the field. Climbing, jumping, and racing through the seats and stands is prohibited. Garbage and recycling must be placed in the bins provided. Pets are not permitted inside the fenced area. Pets outside the fenced area must be on a leash and are not permitted within 5 meters of the playing surface. Pets are prohibited from entering the grandstands. Profanity, aggressive and disrespectful language, or inappropriate behaviors is prohibited. Alcohol, smoking, vaping and cannabis consumption are prohibited (Smoke Free Public Places Bylaw C-1278) Attendees are encouraged to report any violations, concerns or unwelcomed behavior to onsite security or call 780-830-0288. Bicycles, scooters and skateboards are not permitted for use at this facility.
FIELD CARE:	 Footwear on the artificial field must be molded rubber cleats, field shoes or running shoes. Avoid repetitive drills, digging and kicking as it may damage the field. Please keep food, non-water drinks (i.e., sport drinks), glass containers, sunscreen, metal cleats off the field. Marking, taping, or painting on any surface is prohibited. Chairs, tables, tents etc. are prohibited on the field.
BANNERS, TENTS & SIGNS:	 Banners and signs must not be posted, hung or attached to the Facility or fencing without prior approval. Staking of sharp objects (including flags, shade structures or tents) into the field is prohibited.
FOOD AND BEVERAGE:	 Food is prohibited on the field. Beverages are prohibited on the field, excepting water stored in a non-breakable container. Unless otherwise stated, bringing outside food and beverages into the facility is not permitted. Food and beverages must instead be purchased through on-site vendors.
