

Registration Fee

Team Sport: Coaches/Schools Failing to Attend Mandatory Coaches Meeting: Any team (football, volleyball, basketball, curling, rugby 7s, rugby 15s, team handball) that attends provincials as the zone/regional representative and fails to attend or send a team representative to the mandatory coaches meeting will be fined a fee of \$250 for failing to send a representative to the coaches meeting. The Executive will have the sole discretion to waive the penalty based on the rationale provided by the school.

Discipline and Misconduct

Breaches of the ASAA Code of Ethics are treated seriously, and as a host we are required to report any breaches to the ASAA office where action may occur. As stated in the ASAA Code of Ethics, "any conduct, including, but not limited to ejections, fighting and drugs and alcohol use, that results in dishonor to the athlete, the team, the school or the ASAA will not be tolerated." (page 19-20)

Abusive behaviours such as vulgar, obscene language or gestures may be cause for expulsion from the gymnasium for players, coaches or fans.

Protests/Grievance

As per ASAA policy, a grievance committee has been organized to handle discipline and appeals. The committee will have the authority to address issues of a serious nature that may occur before, during or after a Provincial Championship match, or to hear appeals for the automatic suspension resulting from an ejection (see ASAA 2024/2025 Policy Handbook). The committee may include, but not limited to, the tournament chairperson, an official and two coaches not in conflict with the issue. Coaches wishing to volunteer may do so at the coaches meeting. All grievances will be referred to the Tournament Chair who will in turn make a presentation to the Grievance Committee. The decision of this committee is final and not subject to appeal.

- Display an outstanding act of sportsmanship, ethics or integrity


Spectators/Parents Code of Conduct


- Consistently give positive feedback to players and others


