#### Payments:

Entry Fee: 650.00 per team + \$1 per athlete Loonie Fee

The entry fee includes the cost for the officials, ASSA fees, as well as a Certified Athletic Trainer to be onsite for the duration of the weekend at Olds Koinonia as directed by the ASAA.

ALL PAYMENTS, including the entry fee and ASAA "Pay It Forward Scholarship" Loonie Fee, must be paid in one cheque payable to Olds Koinonia Christian School, to be handed in at the team's practice time on Wednesday. Teams will receive their tournament ID's and welcome package upon payment.

#### **Banquet:**

There will be a Lasagna night Wednesday evening that all teams are encouraged to attend. This event will be held at Home Church in Olds (4513 52 Ave Olds, AB) from 7:00 PM to 8:30 PM. ## Parking:

Parking will be limited on Thursday, March 20th during school hours, please park in the south lot and carpool if at all possible for this day. There will be parking attendants Thursday morning to help direct parking prior to Opening Ceremonies. Parking along the front of the school is reserved for school buses only during the hours of 8:15 AM - 9:00 AM and 2:30 PM - 3:30 PM on Thursday. Parents and spectators, please do not park along the front of the school at any time over the weekend, as we would like to keep these lanes open for team buses.

#### **Practice Times:**

Practice times will be available on Wednesday, March 19th from 12:00 PM to 5:00 PM. Each team will be allotted one 30 minute time slot, which will be scheduled to coordinate with teams traveling from longer distances. Practices will be timed and when time is up, teams will be required to leave the gymnasium. Teams waiting to use the court for their practice must wait outside the gymnasium in the entrance. Please avoid watching the other teams practice while waiting. The final practice schedule will be posted on the Practice Times website page as well as updated in the information package as soon as all teams have registered.

Please arrive 20 minutes prior to your scheduled practice to get individual photos taken for your lanyards.

#### **Change Rooms:**

Change rooms are located inside the gymnasium. There will be designated home and away change rooms. Please do not leave any belongings in the change rooms during games. You can access the change room after half time of the game prior to yours. Each team will also be assigned a team room for Thursday evening, Friday, and Saturday. Teams can store their belongings in these rooms between games if they choose.

## Coach/Captain's Meeting:

The Coach/Captain's Meeting will be held virtually and concurrently on Tuesday, March 18 at 7:00 PM. The head official will be in attendance.

Having a coach and player representative in attendance at these meetings is **MANDATORY** as this is where pertinent championship information will be provided. Failure to attend this meeting may result in a fine as per the ASAA. Questions will also be answered at this time.

#### Plaques:

The consolation plaque, fourth place plaque, third place plaque and bronze medals will all be handed out at the conclusion of each respective game. This will allow teams to start heading home earlier if needed. Closing Ceremonies and gold/silver award presentations will take place after the final game on Saturday.

#### **Games Schedule:**

Please note that the highest ranked team will be designated as the Home team and traditionally wear their light colored uniforms, although this is up to the home team. The Olds Koinonia Royals will always be designated as the Home Team.

#### Results:

Game results will be posted on the championship website as well as in the foyer outside the gymnasium of OKCS. No results will be physically posted at Didsbury High School.

## Practice/Warm-Up Basketballs:

Teams will need to bring their own, clearly marked, warm-up balls to use throughout the tournament.

#### **Team Host/Hostess**

There will be one or two host students assigned to each team during the tournament to assist them when needed. They will also be with the teams during the Opening Ceremonies and will lead teams into the gym.

#### **Spectator Code of Conduct:**

We will be adhering to the ASAA Spectator Code of Conduct:

Spectators, both student and adult, must demonstrate courtesy and good sportsmanship by positive cheers of encouragement for their team, not against the opposing team. This is evidenced by the absence of booing and vulgarities. Spectators must also show proper acceptance of officials' judgment.

Artificial noisemakers are not permitted during provincial championship tournaments/events. These noisemakers may include but are not limited to: air horns, cowbells, plastic tube horns, garbage can lids, etc. The provincial championship host shall have the authority to eject from the competition facility individuals who, following a warning, refuse to comply with this requirement.

#### **Hospitality Rooms:**

There will be a coaches lounge and a tournament official's room. The coaches lounge will be located in room 101 towards the south end of the school. The Official's room will be located in the school staff room located just outside the gymnasium. Signage will be posted. Both of these rooms will have complimentary snacks and drinks for the Coaches and Officials and a space to relax between games.

#### **School Requests:**

Please be advised that classes will be in session for both OKCS and Didsbury High School students for Wednesday and Thursday. Please be courteous and respectful during this time, keeping team traffic to the gym section of the school. There is to be absolutely no warming up or balls bouncing outside of the gymnasium. Outdoor shoes will not be permitted on the gym floor at any time, clean indoor shoes are permitted.

Spectators will be permitted to shoot in sock feet during half-time at each game following the floor sweeping. Shooting will not be permitted during time outs or between quarters.

# Sportsmanship:

Sportsmanship is vitally important and highly valued by the ASAA. There will be a Sportsmanship plaque awarded to the team that displays appropriate individual and team conduct/sportsmanship throughout the Championship. Pins and keychains will be handed out throughout the event to individuals, including spectators, who display sportsmanship in their words and actions. The sportsmanship committee will be deciding who receives these awards.

#### **Medical Services:**

A certified athletic trainer will be on site at OKCS at all times and will be available to help with injuries needing attention. She will be located in the gym under the score clock. Olds Hospital and Care Centre is approximately a 10 minute drive from OKCS. Emergency Action Plan - Appendix D

# Maps/Directions:

# Rules/Policy:

It is incumbent upon all coaches and participants to be aware of ASAA Policy. Specifically, for this event, player eligibility (p. 21-26), supervision policy (p. 29), and basketball policy (p. 45-50).

# **Discipline and Misconduct:**

Breaches of the ASAA Code of Ethics are treated seriously, and as host we are required to report any breaches to the ASAA office where action may occur. As stated in the ASAA Code of Ethics, "the executive committee or its host/designated representative shall have authority to direct any person to immediately leave any premises or venue hosting any ASAA sanctioned event if that person:

- a. Exhibits rude or abusive behavior to any other person
- b. Uses vulgar, obscene or abusive language and/or gestures
- c. Fails to promptly follow any reasonable direction given to that person by the designated representative of the ASAA" (p. 14-16)

If a player or coach is disqualified from a game that player or coach will receive a one game suspension. If it is the teacher sponsor that is disqualified, and no other teacher sponsor is available for that team, the team will not be allowed to participate in their following game.

#### **Grievance Committee:**

The committee will have the authority to address issues of a serious nature that may occur before, during, or after the Provincial Championship, or to hear appeals of the automatic suspension resulting from an ejection.



#### **EMERGENCY ACTION PLAN**

- 1) First aid kit and ice will be available in the First Aid Room located in the gymnasium storage room. AED is located in the school staff room.
- 2) Ambulance 9-1-1. Olds Hospital 403-556-3381
- 3) Enter the school through the Main doors. Gym is located straight through the main doors but please follow signage indicating the path for spectators.
- 4) See Appendix E for best route to hospital

# When an injury occurs:


- 1) Take control of the situation. Exercise universal precautions related to blood/body fluids.
- 2) Do not move the student if they cannot move themselves. Do not remove their uniform unless deemed necessary.
- 3) Assess and evaluate the severity of the situation and decide if further assistance is required.
- 4) If an ambulance is required, then determine the action required to remove the athlete from the playing surface.
- 5) If an ambulance is called: direct one person (the coach of the injured player) to call the ambulance and give the pertinent information to them. Include location, address, and extent of injury. Ask the person to report back with an ETA.
- 6) Remain with injured the player and address any concerns they have while awaiting medical attention.
- 7) Do not give food or drink to the injured athlete unless required because of existing medical conditions (Ex. Diabetes).
- 8) Stay calm and reassuring.
- 9) Once the ambulance arrives, explain the situation, and what has been done for the injured athlete.
- 10) Designate an adult to accompany the injured athlete to the hospital.
- 11) Parents/guardians of the injured athlete must be contacted as soon as possible following the injury.

#### PROTOCOL IN EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY

- 1) Call Ambulance or Fire Department 9-1-1
- 2) Olds Koinonia Christian School 32237 Range Rd 13 403-556-4038
- 3) Indicate location and nature of the injury.
- 4) Report to Coach/Administrator
- 5) Meet Ambulance.
