### **Event Information**

**Coaches and Captains Meeting -** Coaches meeting will be held on Tuesday, March 18, at 8:00 pm via a google meet link which will be sent out to you on Sunday, March 16, 2025. Failure to have a team representative there will result in a \$250 fine. The link will be posted here as well when it is available.

**Practice and Team Photo Schedules -** There was a google sheets document linked <u>here</u> that was sent out on Sunday, March 15, to all Athletic Directors of the competing schools and we will have a sign up for team photos and practice times at Holy Trinity High School, Ecole McTavish High School, and Westwood High School. One hour time slots which start at 3:00 pm at Holy Trinity (Until 9 pm), 4:30 at Ecole McTavish (until 8:30 pm), and Westwood High School 3:00 to 7:00.

**Fees -** Fees for the tournament will be \$695. This includes the registration fee (\$560) and the athletic therapist (\$135). Cheques can be made out to the host school. Because of ongoing labour action, we are unable to take E-Transfer at this time.

There is also an additional fee for the ASAA Pay it Forward \$1.00 per athlete which will need to be added when submitting payment.



## **Holy Trinity Parking Map**


