

Registration Deadline

All registration forms must be completed online by 12:00, noon, Monday, November 22nd.

1. Please go to <http://provincials.asaa.ca> and select the volleyball icon. Then select 2021 1A Boys Provincial Championship - École Héritage.
2. Click on the Registration link on the left-hand menu bar. Follow the instructions carefully, ensuring that the information is correct. The system will lead you through the registration process. This will include a section for you to upload a team picture (please upload a high-resolution photo), team logo, team history, team photo confirmation and Loonie scholarship fee.
3. Once you click on save content/submit on the bottom of the page, the information will be sent to the host. When a confirmation email is sent to you, it will include a link back to the registration page where you can edit the information, if necessary.

Mandatory Acknowledgment Form

ASAA Policy - A form acknowledging the risk of attending/participating in the ASAA Provincials form **MUST** be signed by the parent/guardian of every student and every coach/volunteer. Any student coach or volunteer who appears without a signed form will not be permitted to participate.

Face Masks

ASAA Policy – Face masks must be always worn by all individuals, including athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers, etc., except when athletes are competing. Athletes must wear masks while on the bench, including the **Libero** unless the 2-meter social distance is maintained. Athletes can take their masks off when going to the substitution zone.

Pre-Game/Post-Game

ASAA Policy –Captains will not shake hands and physical distancing will occur between players and officials; masks must be worn during captain meeting. Teams will not shake hands after the game.

Side Switching

ASAA Policy – Teams will remain on their side of the court for the duration of the match. The home team will establish their bench, and the opponent may not select it during the coin toss.

Team Photo

After you have completed the registration process, please send a team picture directly to (program committee email), this will ensure we use the best quality picture for our program, as the website lowers the resolution of the picture.

ASAA Policy – no team practices will be available prior to or during the tournament.

ASAA Policy – there are no opening, closing ceremonies or banquet for the 2021 edition of the volleyball championships.

Host/Hostess

École Héritage is unable to assign Host/Hostesses to each team. Parent ambassadors from the host team will be available during the tournament to assist any team.

Photographs & Action Shots

ASAA Policy – No team photos will be taken onsite and need to be provided by each school.

Action shots will be taken during the tournament by Foto Antonio for a fee of \$150 per team. Each team will be provided with one thumb drive with all the photos. To assist the photographer in getting the most action shots possible of every player, **please wear your team jersey at all pre-game warmups**. A consent form is required for all players. The consent form will be sent to coaches upon provincial qualification and must be submitted by email to Nicole Walisser (nicolewalisser@csno.ab.ca) prior to the competition.

Consolation Winner

ASAA Policy – Award ceremonies will implement proper physical distancing between teams. A designated person from each team will retrieve any medals and or banners and distribute them to the appropriate individuals. Masking is required.

Sportsmanship Award

A sportsmanship committee, with the help of the participating teams and tournament officials, will select the **Fr. Gallagher** sportsmanship award winner for the most sportsmanlike team. Teams will be provided with a sportsmanship ballot for voting. The winner will be notified the week after provincials and a presentation will be made at the recipient's school following the championship. Sportsmanship pins will also be presented throughout the tournament to those athletes, coaches, and spectators who exemplify sportsmanship.

Team Rooms/ Change Rooms

The Baytex Energy Centre has 2 fieldhouse change rooms. Pre-game and post-game team meetings will take place in the designated team bleacher. Please do not leave any items in the change room, as other teams will be using it during your game. Please vacate the change room within 30 minutes after your game to ensure the next team has adequate time to prepare.

Hospitality Room for Coaches & Officials

ASAA Policy – Hospitality rooms will not be available for officials, coaches, or volunteers. We will be offering refreshments for coaches and volunteers that will be individually packaged. There will be a distribution process implemented.

Spectator Information

The Baytex Energy Center is currently operating under the REP, as outlined by the Government of Alberta. Anyone entering the facility over the age of 12 years is to provide proof of vaccination (full dosage administered at least 14 days prior), negative covid test (taken within 72 hours), or medical exemption letter upon entry.

Athlete participants, under the age of 18 years will not be required to be screened for the purpose of the tournament.

All coaches, referees, score keepers, parent/teacher volunteers etc. over 18 years will be screened as per the REP.
