Re: Back to Work Legislation Impact on SSA Fall Championships

Good morning, SSA Membership.

The Provincial Government enacted back-to-work legislation on ATA teachers on Monday, October 27. While the SSA Office does not have a full picture of the ramifications of this, we can communicate the following in the event that schools resume all regular activities:

- 1. SSA Provincial Cross Country Championships have been moved to spring 2026, provided that there is a host in place, and a date and location can be determined.
- 2. The winter season of play can start on November 1, 2025.
- 3. In line with the contingency plans communicated in the <u>memo of September 30, 2025</u>, and on the condition that at least six zones can determine their representatives, the SSA Office can work with hosts to operate the following provincial championships:
 - a. Football: League play can restart / conclude as per local decision making.
 Zones have until Saturday, November 8 to determine provincial representation.
 5A rankings will follow the <u>updated timeline</u>.
 SSA Provincial Quarterfinals will commence on Friday & Saturday, November 14 & 15 with the Alberta Bowl held in Edmonton on November 28 & 29.
 - Volleyball: League play can restart / conclude as per local decision making.
 The second ranking period has been cancelled, final rankings and wildcard
 allocations will follow the <u>published timeline</u>.
 Zones have until Saturday, November 22 to determine provincial representation.
 SSA Provincial Championships will be held on November 27-29.

If schools do not resume all regular activities, there will be further communication once we have more information.
